

Digital Terrestrial: postponement in Lombardy confirmed

Postponement of the change over to digital terrestrial broadcasting in Lombardy has now been officially confirmed. Our region is not going to switch the analogue signal off in spring, but will do so in September or October. The **only channels** that have to comply with the **May 2010 deadline are RAI 2 and Rete 4**.

The calendar was changed today by the Italian Committee on Digital Broadcasting, in order not to cause inconvenience for viewers during the eagerly awaited football World Cup, and to guarantee coverage of the regional elections.

In Lazio, the definitive change over to digital broadcasting created great problems (although this has been denied by the state broadcasting company, RAI) because of the redistribution of the frequencies, which can only take place once the space occupied by the analogue signals has been freed up.
