Saronno admitted to the regional meeting on pollution.

Saronno town council **will be admitted to the regional meeting on air quality**. After a two month wait, the Mayor received the answer, on Wednesday afternoon, with a call from the regional councillor for environment, **Marcello Raimondi**. Saronno had been barred from the meeting, because it was a town with fewer than **40,000 inhabitants**, although it does have 39,700 inhabitants, and it is one of the towns with the most critical levels of pollution. The Mayor, **Luciano Porro**, who had sent a request to the Region at the beginning of January, said, "We're happy with this answer. They've already reassured us that the Region **plans to implement an anti-pollution plan**, which is what we have sought since we took office here two years ago. Now we will be presenting our requests to the official meeting, **hoping that we can make progress in this direction** to deal with the problem"
