Maga is reborn from its ashes: “Record result in just two years”

Everything is ready: the new roof is in place, the rooms are fully renovated and **the Maga Museum is ready to return to reopen completely.**

It is now two years since that 14th February when a thick black smoke enveloped the skies of Gallarate destroying much of the structure. Since then, the museum of contemporary art has lived particularly exciting moments: the first temporary transfer to the Milan Triennale and Villa Reale in Monza, then the re-opening of a first wing of the structure, now the definitive return to normality.

But before returning to the exhibition space we will have to wait a few more weeks. The definitive reopening will take place on 18th April with the opening of the exhibition
