Whirlpool, today the workshop on the future of the Comerio area

Following the Memorandum of Understanding signed on November 3 for the realisation of a “Feasibility Study for the conversion and enhancement of the Whirlpool area”, **a workshop was held today aimed at finding solutions for area re-use.** About thirty representatives from industries, universities, institutions, sport and culture world attended the workshop. The work continued through all day and was well attended.
